The Food Pantry community service program provides food for individuals and families in need of assistance in Central Bucks county. The Food Pantry is a designated food distribution site of the Bucks County Opportunity Council and receives government allocated funds for specific food items on an annual budget basis. While these funds provide the foundations for this program, additional funds and donated foods are also provided from area churches, synagogues, organizations, businesses and individuals.

The Food Pantry serves the guests (those in need) of the Bucks County Opportunity Council and individuals referred from churches and organizations.

Individuals or families in need may receive assistance from the Food Pantry without referral by contacting any of the telephone numbers listed or by coming to the Food Pantry during normal days and times of operation.

The Food Pantry is entirely operated and staffed by volunteers. Food, supply, and monetary donations directly benefit those who need the help of the Food Pantry.
